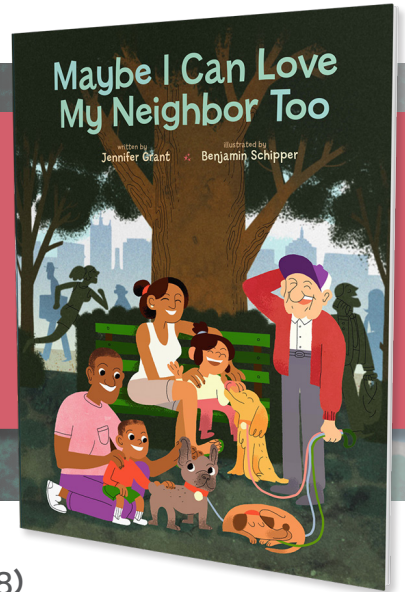


Lines of Love
