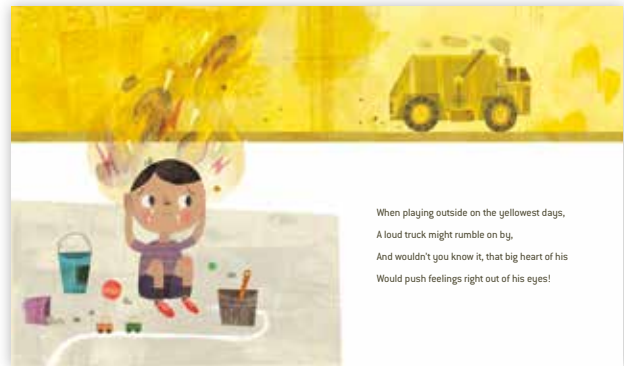


The Boy with Big, Big Feelings

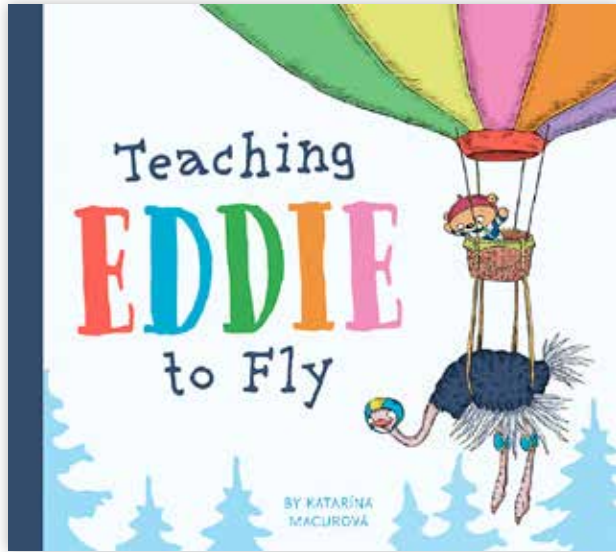

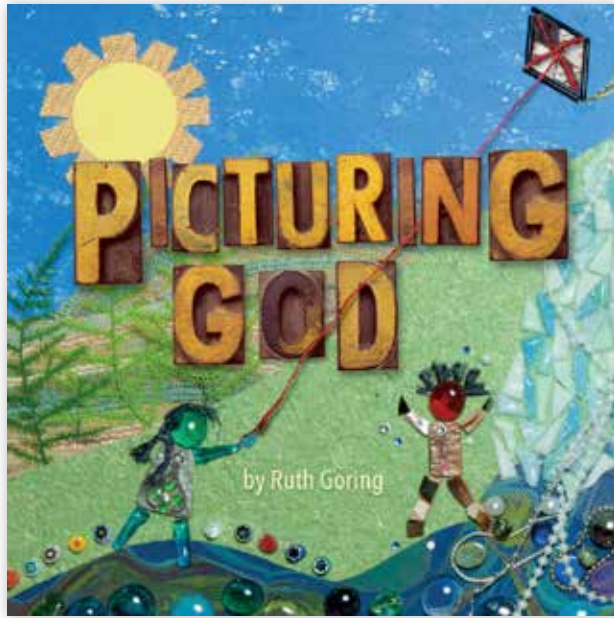

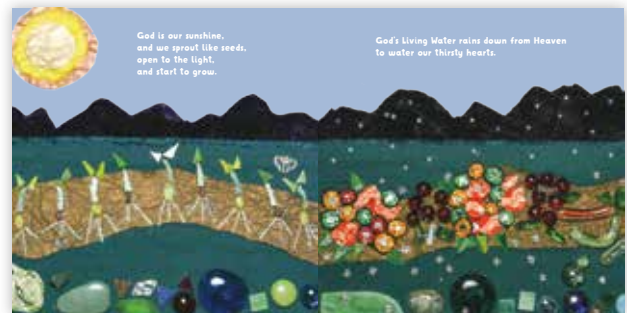


Picturing God
